CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & CATEGORY EXPLANATIONS

ENTRIES, STABLING, CAMPING & PAYMENT

via www.globalentriesonline.com.au

LATE ENTRIES: Riders whose entries are already accepted for the show will be allowed to change entries on the day for horses already entered but they will incur a \$5.00 late fee per class plus the entry fee. This will be strictly adhered to. **No accounts will be run payment must be made when entering.**

CHANGE OF ENTRY: The fee of \$5.00 will apply for change of entry from one class to another once entries have closed ie. Out of one class and into another.

DRAWS: will be completed at the beginning of the week prior to the show and will be found on Global entries. Saturday's draws will be available from Wednesday, Sundays draws Saturday night and Mondays draws Sunday night.

They will also be posted near the clubhouse. Changes at the show must be done by 2pm the day before at the show office.

REFUNDS: A full refund (less a \$20 admin fee) will be given if an email of the scratching is received before close of entries. Email to espjane@bigpond.com

After close of entries a 50% refund of entries on receipt of a doctors or veterinary certificate. Must be received via email to espane@bigpond.com

Refund applications must be made within 7 days after the show. 100% refund will be given if the show is cancelled.

Refund of stables or yards will only be given if the event organiser is notified by close of entries. Otherwise no refund for a stable or yard can be given.

SCRATCHINGS: Please send scratchings to espjane@bigpond.com If you scratch after the close of entries you will still be required to pay for your yard or stable booking. You will only receive money back on these if done before close of entry.

INDEMNITY FORMS: Are part of the entry to the show. They must be read carefully and ticked off by the Rider. Riders under the age of 18 must have their parent's permission to tick and enter or an authorised Legal Guardian.

Riders will not be allowed to compete until the indemnity and conditions of entry are ticked off when entering.

DOGS must be tied up or on a leash at all times. No dogs are allowed in the jumping or practice arenas at any time.

If numbers require changing events into different arenas the organiser has the right to change the classes if they feel it is beneficially to the competition.

COATS IN PRESENTATIONS. Riders will be required to wear a coat in presentations. Summer Uniform will be acceptable if weather exceeds a certain temperature, an announcement will be made. If riding without a coat, a proper long sleeved riding shirt with tie or ratcatcher will be permissible.

If wearing a back protector you have the option of wearing a riding coat or not.

THIS EVENT WILL BE RUN UNDER FEI/EA REGULATIONS.

Australian, European & American Helmet Standards will apply in all rings and riders must wear these helmets at all times when mounted on a horse, this includes presentations and non competition days. Correct riding boots must be worn at all times that riders are mounted on a horse. Anyone riding a horse on the grounds at any time must comply with these stipulations.

The Organising Committee reserves the right, at their absolute discretion, to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations or any aspect of the event they see fit.

PRACTICE ARENAS: Only Riders competing in the current competition may use the final practice area. Only six horses (or less if the marshal or judge decide due to safety) will be allowed in the practice area at any one time.

Other warm up areas will be provided.

VEHICLES: (Bi Centennial Park is a public area and there will be no under age drivers, no driving under the influence of alcohol and no riding on the outside of vehicles.). All road rules will apply.

Cars will be provided with a horse free parking area around the clubhouse.

CROSS COUNTRY FENCES: (Off Limits) Camden's Bi Centennial Equestrian Park has a course of cross country fences. The cross country jumps and water complex's are off limits at all times. Anyone jumping any of these obstacles will be ELIMINATED from the whole show.

PLEASE READ CATEGORY EXPLANATIONS

CATEGORY EXPLANATIONS

Junior: A rider is a "Junior" until the end of the calendar year in which he/she reaches the age of 18 years. (EA Addendum to FEI Rules for Jumping Aug. 2001). If riders are eligible for Young Rider as well they can compete in both, but on different horses.

Young Rider: Competitors may take part in competitions for "Young Riders" from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21 years. (EA Addendum to FEI Rules for Jumping August 2001) If riders are eligible for Junior's as well they can compete in both but on different horses.

Novice Junior: For riders in the year of their 18th Birthday and under. A rider may compete in the Junior and Novice Junior but on different horses and also if their age overlaps Novice Junior and Novice Young Rider but on different horses.

Novice Young Rider: For riders 16 years to 21 years. A rider may compete in the Young Rider and Novice Young Rider but on different horses and if the age overlaps Novice Junior and Novice Young Rider but on different horses.

Child Jumper: Riders are eligible to compete in this category until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14.

Pony Jumper is a horse 14.2hh and under and must be ridden by a rider under 17 yrs on the day of competition. The judge has the right to request any pony to be measured if he/she feels there is a height discrepancy. A measuring steward will be in attendance.

Open Jumper is any rider from the year of their 21st birthday and under to the end of the calendar year, unless age group stated.

MAXIMUM HEIGHTS listed are for the first round of the competition.

OPEN means no restriction on age or level but all riders must be 21 years and under.

STATE TEAMS COMPETITION

The best 3 results in the following competitions will be counted for the State team's competition.

Classes 6,9,20, 22, & 29 Junior classes

Classes 2,5,16,18 & 30 Young Rider Classes

Classes 3,4 & 14,15 FEI Children's Classes Gold, Silver and Bronze Rescue Relay

NSW V NEW ZEALAND YOUNG RIDER CHALLENGE.

The teams for this competition are chosen by the state selectors. It is a competition on borrowed horses.

FEI CHILDREN'S INTERNATIONAL CLASSIC COMPETITION RULES

This is an international event run under international rules by Federation Equestre Internationale.

GOLD TOUR: FEI International Children's Jumping Classic Competition. Riders are eligible to compete in this class from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 14 years. Maximum height in this category 1.20m.

SILVER TOUR: FEI International Children's Jumping Classic. Riders are eligible to compete in this category until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14. Maximum height in this category 1.10m.

BRONZE TOUR: FEI International Children's Jumping Classic. Riders are eligible to compete in this category until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14. Maximum height in this category 1 metre.

You can only compete in ONE FEI Tour/Category. You can compete on two horses in one category. A horse may only compete in one category. You must nominate which horse will be counted for the FEI Final Pointscore.

MEDICATION CONTROL: Swabbing will be done on FEI classes and possibly other classes throughout the competition

FITNESS INSPECTION: Riders competing in the FEI International Children's Classic Gold and Silver Tour will be required to do a Trot Up at either 4pm on Friday afternoon or 7.30am on Saturday morning. We would prefer horses to be trotted up on Friday if possible.
