BIOSECURITY ARRANGEMENTS

On arrival at the Showground all horse competitors must sign an indemnitywaiver if not signed and sent with entries, at the horse shed.

NO INDEMNITY NO ENTRY INTO SHOW

Horse competitors should be aware that in the case of a quarantine lock down, the owner is responsible for his/her own welfare and his/her horse's welfare and all costs incurred.

HORSE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GENERAL RULES.

PLEASE NOTE: INDEMITY FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND LODGED WITH ENTRIES.

Please make sure that you complete the correct indemnity forms, they must be the ones for the horse section.

Copy of EA and/or Breed and Society Registrations are to accompany entries. Biosecurity - record of attendance to be completed for every horse on the ground.

- 1 ENTRY FEE: Unless otherwise stated entry is \$4.00 per class. Late Entry, additional Fee: \$8.00 per event.
- 2 STABLING: To be confirmed with Chief Horse Steward. There are a limited number of Stables in the Stockman's Memorial Shed that will be allocated to stallions only. These stables will be allocated at a cost of \$25.00 per stallion to be paid to the secretary with entries. \$10.00 will be refunded at the completion of the show if satisfactorily cleaned. No horse is to be put in this shed or the stables without prior sanction of the Stabling Marshall. Other stables \$10. A limited number of standing "tie-in" stalls are available for horses at the show grounds at a fee of \$5.00 per stall. Payment to be made with entries. Payment does not necessarily guarantee a stall and should be confirmed prior to the show. A list of stall holders will be displayed at Horse Shed. Preference will be given to long distance travelers. Any extenuating circumstances will be dealt with by the Marshall.

We have Portable yards available for hire \$15.00. Stalls should be left clean at the end of show. Failure to do this could incur loss of allocation at the next show.

There is plenty of room to construct temporary stalls. These MUST be of solid construction per EA ruling 2010.

Please leave all areas clean and tidy. You are expected to rake your area after use.

- 3 All events will be conducted in accordance with the E.A Show Horse Handbook and Jumping rules and amendments, FEI, HRCAV, Sporting Horse Australia and Breed Society/Association rules
- 4 Neither the Organising Committee of any competition to which these rules apply nor the EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- **5 MEASURING:** All horses must be **measured**. Proof of measurement must be supplied in the form of a **current** Wentworth Show Ag Society or in the form of a current height certificate from the RASV or EA. Measuring Certificate to be produced **on demand**. The measuring steward will be in attendance for measuring between 8.00 a.m and 9.00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. Alternative times can be arranged with the measuring steward. Enquiries at the horse shed.
- **6** All STALLIONS and COLTS (2 years and over) must be bitted, led and/or ridden by an adult over 18 years. Stallions permitted in stallion classes only unless otherwise stated. Guidelines developed by the E.A for the code of conduct for stallion owners will be followed. For a copy of these guidelines contact the secretary of the different Breed Societies for their rules.
- 7 The Committee reserves the right to alter, cancel, change or combine classes without prior notice to competitors
- 8 The Wentworth Show Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibit. It shall be the condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the society blameless or indemnified against any legal proceedings that may arise from such an accident.

- 9 THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
- 10 PROTESTS must be lodged in writing with the secretary within two (2) hours from the completion of the event in question. Protests in all cases must be accompanied by the deposit of \$50.00. The deposit will be forfeited to the society should the protest be deemed frivolous. All protests will be heard by the Show Society Disputes Committee and the Chief Horse Steward.
- 11 The society reserves the right to exclude from competition any entry that behaves in an unruly or dangerous manner. They may be asked to be removed and no refund considered.
- 12 DRESS: All competitors must be correctly and suitably attired whilst in the arena. EA RULING ON HELMETS APPLIES. It is COMPULSORY TO WEAR AN EA APPROVED STANDARD HELMET AT ALL TIMES WHILST MOUNTED. These are as follows AS/NZ38: 1998., EN 1384 European Standard ASTM F 1163. American Standard. Riders under 18 years are not permitted to wear top boots in riding classes.

Please note - Mounted riders to wear **approved footwear** only when on the grounds.

- 13 AGE OF RIDERS: Birth certificates may be need to be supplied for riders 18 years and under. Age is at the day of the show. (See Show jumping Section for age requirements.)
- 14 OVER MOUNTING of small ponies will not be tolerated. Riders of small ponies deemed by the Judge to be too tall or too heavy will not be permitted.

 The Judge's decision will be final.
- 15 NOVICE: Not to have won at an Agricultural Show.
- 16 INTERMEDIATE: Not to have won a first, second or third prize competing singularly at

any Australian Royal Show.

- 17 CHAMPION: Pony, Galloway and Hack to be Champion in one ring only Saturday. No refund on entry. Sunday classifies as a new show. All Champions eligible for Supremes.
- **18 PRIZES:** First prize money only paid if there are 4 or more entries. No prize money if 3 entries or less. All prize money paid out in Harness Classes.
- 19 RANDOM SWABBING: May take place in accordance with the EA and dealt with accordingly by the Wentworth Show Society and the EA. Shows retain the right to test horses for prohibited substances.
- 20 DISTRICT EVENTS: 80km from Wentworth Post Office.
- **21 AMBULANCE**: An ambulance available in an emergency, ring 000. First Aid in Swabbing Shed next to the Horse Shed and the near Evacuation area near the Show Jumping arena if required.
- **22 IDENTIFICATION:** EA Performance Cards or a card carried by each competitor with the name of the horse. Rider and/or owner will assist the stewards in each ring.
- 23 RIBBONS: Should competitors wish to donate ribbons back to the show for recycling there will be a box provided in the Horse Shed. Returned ribbons will entitle competitors to free Ribbons Raffle tickets, ask at the Horse Shed.
- **24 ARMBANDS:** Armband numbers to be worn in all rings except show jumping ring. All entrants will be allocated a number. \$5.00 refundable when showing complete and armband returned or use your own with number allocated.
- 25 No Refund of entry fees after closing date unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of completion of event.
- **26** Notify Stewards at Horse Office of any falls or injuries and complete Incident Form.
- 27 All electrical leads and equipment to be currently tested and tagged by a licensed tester. All leads to be covered or disconnected during the day.
- 28 Show Jumpers All Horses, Riders & owners must be registered with Equestrian Australia to be eligible to compete in Affiliated classes. Junior Riders MUST be registered with EA. A copy of current E.A Certificate or Registration must be sent with entry forms for entries to be accepted. Current Performance Cards must be available on request by place-getters at the end of the event in question. Prize money will be withheld until certificates presented.

Rules and Conditions

Entries close 14th August 2016 - NO telephone or late entries will be accepted.

Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place in each test (depending on number of entrants in the test - as per rules). Prize money will be awarded in tests with a minimum of four (4) competitors entered.

The draw will be completed by & will be emailed (please write email address clearly) or sent by post if the entrant supplies a stamped, self-addressed, long envelope. It will also be posted on the Wentworth Show facebook page.

Entries will only be accepted if the entry form is completed and signed, including the Indemnity and Waiver Statement and accompanied with the full payment. Entries received without payment will not be scheduled into the draw.

This event will be held in accordance with the Rules of the EA. It is a condition of entry that competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with the rules. The National Dressage Rules can be downloaded freely from www.equestrian.org.au

OFFICIAL TESTS: Horses and Ponies must be registered with the EA and owned by a current financial EA member and must have:

A) Registration papers available on the day of competition

b) Must have a current Dressage Performance Card

RESTRICTED: Open to all riders and mount size is not restricted. Riders/horses need not be registered with EA

PREPARATORY TESTS are open to horse/rider combinations who have not won more than 3 Preparatory Tests (with min 5 competitors) or scored 70% or above in a Preliminary Test. Combinations who still wish to enter at this level must ride HC and declare their intention to do so, at time of entry.

JUNIOR RIDER TESTS: A Junior Rider is eligible to compete from the start of the year they turn 12 to the end of the year they turn 18 OR 10 years if riding a Pony

PONY DRESSAGE TESTS: Open to all riders competing on ponies / galloways meeting the height requirement. Mount size is restricted to 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes. Riders/Ponies need not be registered with EA.

The estimated height of the pony is to be included on entry forms

RESTRICTIONS: Horses may only compete at 2 consecutive levels e.g. Novice/ Elementary. Each horse is restricted to a maximum of 3 tests while each rider is restricted to a maximum of 6 tests. A maximum of 2 horses per rider, per event will be allowed.

In accordance with EA rulings a horse must be a minimum of 3 years of age to compete.

SECTION E - HORSES - Continued

RIDING ATTIRE: All competitors are required to wear an AS/NZ3838 (current Aust & NZ), or EN1384 (European) or ASTN F1 163 (USA) standard helmet at all times when mounted on a horse. Approved short or long riding boots, gloves, collared & sleeved shirt & generally a neat and tidy appearance is required. If gaiters/chappettes are worn, the exposed side must be full grain leather, suede on the exposed side is not permitted.

Official combinations, compulsory dress as per the rules, EA registration & Bridle No. required.

All horses and riders must be gear checked prior to competing in each test. Failure to do so may incur elimination

Callers are allowed (except for FEI tests)

Results will be displayed outside the pavilion on the day. If you require tests to be mailed please provide stamped, self-addressed, long envelope.

APPEALS: Must be made in writing and submitted within half an hour of the Competition concluding. Appeals cost \$50, which is refundable if the appeal is upheld

Disclaimer must be signed. You will not be permitted to ride if this form is not signed.

No refund of entry fees will be given after the closing date. 50% of entry fees will be refunded if a veterinary or medical certificate is produced no later than 24 hours after the event. Please notify any scratching ASAP to help with the smooth running of the event. On arrival please check the draw as it may vary.

- Safety helmets are optional for senior riders but are compulsory for all riders under 18 yrs
- · Western/stock or half breed saddles can be used as long as the saddle has swing fenders
- · Breast plate/crupper may be used
- Leg wraps can be in the colour of the horse
- Bridles are to be of western/stock type and the bits can be snaffle, curb or bitless
- · Romal reins are to be used with one hand
- Split reins can be used with two hands on horses of any age
- If split reins are used in one hand there should not be finger put between the reins.
 Two hands can be used at the end of the free walk and free jog to replace reins.
- A junior horse is classed as 5yrs & under and is to be ridden in a snaffle bit
- · A caller is permitted
- Plaiting and braiding is optional
- Quiet use of the voice and clicking of the tongue is permitted
- Riders may ride multiple horses at the discretion of the entry secretary
- A gear check will be required for all competitors prior to competing

Not permitted:

- Tonge ties
- Slip or gag bits
- Martingales, tie-downs, running reins or any gadgets to be used while in the test or in the warm up
- Drop,flash or grackle nosebands
- Mechanical hackamores or twisted bits
- Any kind of boot leg protection
- Fly hoods
