













CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRIES

- Entries for all events close on Saturday 14 November 2015.
- Late entries and class changes will incur a \$5 surcharge which will be strictly adhered to.
 Late entries will be added to bottom of the draw.
- No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee, camping/stabling fee and EFA numbers.
- No telephone entries accepted.
- Refund of entries will be given for scratchings made before 8:00am Friday 20 November 2015. Thereafter a veterinary certificate must be produced to claim refund.
- Number of entries per class will be limited.

RULES

- The FEI Rules for Jumping and EA Addendum to the Rules will apply.
- All horses in Ring 1 must be currently registered and hold current performance cards with the EA.
- All riders must be members of the ACT Showjumping Club or EA.
- Australian helmet standards will apply.
 All riders must wear approved boots and helmet whilst mounted, including presentations, training, before and after the event.
- All dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed onto the competition arena or practice arenas at any time.
- All riders competing at this event will be expected to have read these rules and conditions and accept and acknowledge the wavier forms signed with the EA.
- NO ABUSE OF OFFICIALS OR VOLUNTEERS
 WILL BE TOLERATED. Failure to follow
 instruction from the Organising Committee
 members will result in disqualification from
 the event.



JUNIOR. YOUNG RIDER AND AMATEUR

- Young Rider definition: From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21 years.
- **Junior Rider definition:** From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18 years.
- Amateur Rider definition: A rider 21 years or over who has never competed in an Olympic Games or WEG, not competed in Part 1 or Part 2 at Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne or Adelaide Royal shows in the past two years or in a World Cup qualifier in the past ten years. Amateur riders cannot enter a class that is higher than the designated Amateur class at the Show. Excluded are horses that have competed in classes higher than the designated Amateur class.
- ACT Showjumping Club Ring 3 Point Score: Horseland Canberra is providing a Collegiate saddle for a point score covering Ring 3. The point score is 5 points for a win in the first two classes entered each day, going down to 1 point for 5th. In the event of equal points, the overall winner will be drawn from the hat by the ACT Showjumping Club President. Other participants in the draw will receive \$200.
- **NSW Amateur of the Year 2015 Series:** Class 10 is part of the series. To view the rules please visit www.jumpingnsw.equestrian.org.au.

DRAW

- All classes in each ring will be conducted in draw order. Preliminary draws will be available for viewing at the office on the day. Draw order must be followed, subject to next rule.
- Ring 1 is to take priority over Ring 2 and Ring 3.

CAMPING

- Equestrian Park is being hired for the event and is available for camping from 19 November until 22 November 2015. Camping after that date is also available.
- The minimum camping fee is \$20 per horse carrying vehicle, which will cover up to three (3) nights.
- A fee of \$10 will be charged for each additional night camped.
- Camping fees must accompany entries.
- There are no showers or powered sites on the grounds.

EQUESTRIAN PARK HORSE LEVY

 Equestrian Park is run by volunteers and its maintenance and development is funded by users. A horse levy of \$4 per horse applies.

YARDS

 Open yards are available for the duration of the show.

Yards - \$40 per horse

- Temporary fencing is allowed in areas allocated. This costs \$5 per horse.
- Yard fees must accompany entries.
