Thank you to those shows who were able to conduct a JNSW Amateur Series Class in 2022. Hopefully, this year we will be able to achieve more events again for a successful series to be held. Thank you for previously hosting a Jumping NSW Amateur of the Year Series class. We hope you will be able to host a class for 2023.

The following are the requirements to hold this class and for uniformity and promoting the event we need you to be able to fulfil the following:

- The Organising Committee must be affiliated with ENSW (Agricultural Shows also fall into this category)
- The Class must be an (AM5) Article 238 2.2 or Art. 273 3.3.1
- The first round to be minimum height of 1.15m and maximum 1.20m. If it is to be an indoor class, it should be first round 1.10m
- All references to this class must include "Jumping NSW Amateur of the Year Series Class"
 in your schedule of events and on any online entry system etc. This is extremely
 important so riders know which class is the Series class.
- Only one of your Amateur classes can be a series class at your show, preferably the <u>main</u> Amateur class of your show, even if this is a final with restricted numbers.
- To follow the current National Amateur ruling. See EA website.
- When at all possible, run the class on Saturday or Sunday of your show, not during the week.
- Results (<u>places to 10th</u>) to be sent to <u>espjane@bigpond.com</u> Within the week following the competition.
- Judges sheets to be made available if there are queries.
